

## **Brown Tourist Signs**

Brown signs are used to direct traffic to tourist attractions. The signs are provided by the owner of the establishment subject to various standards and consent being given by the County Council (or Trunk Road Agency if signs are on a Trunk Road).

Eligibility for signs should be discussed with the Traffic Section who will issue application forms on request. If signs are approved by the County Council then the manufacture and installation (by the Council) will be offered on a rechargeable basis.

A non-refundable fee, £75 plus VAT as at February 1998, is charged for a formal application for brown tourist signs. The Council consults Visit Wales, Local Community Council, Local County Councillor and National Park (if appropriate) prior to approval/rejection of an application. Processing of applications may take 3-4 months.
